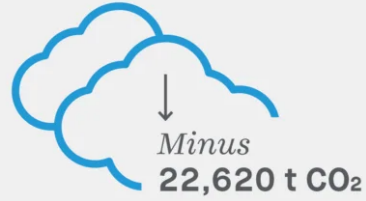
The multicultural KHS family

The majority of the 5,081 employees at KHS may be male, have an average age of 44 and worked for the company for 13 years yet they are one thing above all else: international. The workforce comes from no fewer than 80 different countries: from Honduras through Tanzania to Cambodia and from Australia through Bosnia to Canada.

The company profits from the resulting cultural diversity: different ways of thinking, patterns of experience and areas of expertise create an open working environment where each and every employee can nurture his or her particular talents.



Parallel to its eleven production sites – with five in Germany, two in the USA and one apiece in Mexico, Brazil, India and China – KHS also operates a worldwide sales and service network. The company is represented in 52 countries on all continents with its own subsidiaries and offices, from whence neighboring countries without their own branches of KHS can also be supplied. Thanks to its global network KHS is a reliable partner that is accessible to customers all over the world.



In 2017 and 2018 KHS was able to reduce its carbon footprint considerably. Merely by switching over to LED lighting and introducing a building management system its annual electricity consumption has dropped by 545,000 kWh. But that's not all: compared to 2018 a further 10% in electricity and 5% in heating energy are to be saved by 2025.
